With fishing, biking, hiking, swimming, water sports and camping, Palisade is at the center of outdoor activities in Western Colorado.

Little Bookcliffs Wild Horse Range—One of only 3 areas in the Western U.S. set aside for wild horse herds. It encompasses 30,261 acres of rugged canyons in the Bookcliffs northwest of Palisade. For directions and information, call BLM at (970) 244-3000.

Colorado National Monument—One of the greatest landscapes of the American West. Sheer-walled canyons, towering monoliths, colorful formations, desert bighorn sheep and soaring eagles reflect the environment and history of this canyon country. Call (970) 858-3617 for visitor information.

Island Acres—5 miles east of Palisade. A state park with three lakes (near the Colorado River) where camping, fishing and swimming, make for a one-of-a-kind outdoor experience. (970) 434-3388.

Museum of the West—Offers educational exhibits, supervised dinosaur digs specialty gift shops, and research opportunities. 462 Ute Ave., Grand Junction, Colorado. (970) 242-0971

Dinosaur Journey—Wander among the skeletons and robotic dinosaurs, real fossils, interactive learning centers, and an active paleontology laboratory where you can watch scientists prepare REAL bones! Highway 340 and Jurassic Ct., Fruita. (970) 858-7282
